

# What **impact** will the revisions to the Manure Management Manual have on **you** ?

On October 29, 2011 Pennsylvania DEP released the revised Manure Management Manual. The purpose of the Manual and accompanying supplements is to provide guidelines that comply with DEP regulations concerning animal manures and agricultural process wastewaters.

Who the guidelines pertain to:

All farms that generate or use manure, regardless of the size of farm, including farms that :

1. Pasture livestock or poultry, or
2. Maintain an Animal Concentration Area, or
3. Apply manure to their crop fields
