

The Lower Windsor Township Police Department is accepting applications for Full Time Police Officers who meet the following criteria:

- Must be 21 years of age by the date of the application deadline
- Must have graduated from an accredited high school or possess GED
- Pass a background investigation including checks of references and credit history
- Must be physically, medically, and psychologically fit to perform the essential duties of the job
- Possess a valid Pennsylvania driver's license
- Have successfully completed a certified police academy and have obtained ACT 120 certification based upon the standards set forth by MPOETC; this includes having successfully completed the certification examination

Applicants must establish a residency within a 30-mile radius of any Township border within 90 days of the date of hire. Beginning salary for probationary officer is **\$68,392.03** a year plus benefits.

The Lower Windsor Township is 26.2 square miles. The township has 7,519 residents and the department also supplies police services to East Prospect Borough. We have 6 parks located in the Township and a summer recreation area along the Susquehanna River.

Deadline for Applications is until the position is filled.
